The Windfall by Diksha Basu. Fiction. What does it mean to be nouveau riche in modern India? This comedy of manners highlights a family dealing with the precariousness of social status, insubstantiality of pride, and the natural determination we have to build and share a home.



Secrets in Summer by Nancy Thayer. Fiction. Darcy spends her days at the library and her nights stargazing and contemplating a new relationship. When she is drawn into the summertime dramas of three families, including those of her recently married ex, Darcy is compelled to consider what she truly wants.



Chemistry by Weike Wang. Fiction. Losing her love for her major when her graduate studies become subject to research failures, a university chemistry student in Boston contemplates a marriage proposal from a more successful fellow scientist, while she pursues an entirely different kind of chemistry.


family dog) on their trip around the country.

Fairy Tales by Sheila Nevins. 927.973 N5285.



Marzano-Lesnevich's views about the death penalty and forced her to confront secrets within her own family.





Draft. At the same time, he harbored a dark secret: a dependency on drugs and alcohol. He hit rock bottom, and then with humility and grace, transformed himself.

Set against the tumultuous political backdrop of late '60s Chicago, this fictional graphic diary of 10-year-old Karen Reyes is filled with B-movie horror and pulp monster magazine iconography. Reyes tries to solve the murder of her upstairs neighbor, a

holocaust survivor, while the interconnected stories of those around her unfold.
